

BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS EXPOSURE PROTOCOL

Should someone in your building need to be seen or treated for a BBP exposure (including human bites), please follow the below step-by-step instructions:

1. For any body fluid contact, advise the employee to IMMEDIATELY wash skin with soap and water for 2 minutes and/or flush eye(s)/nose/mouth for 10 minutes with running water (remove contacts).
2. You or the employee must contact the MESD Nurse Consultant as soon as possible at **503-257-1732** for all blood exposure or any body fluid contact to eyes, nose, or mouth or all human bites to bare skin or any puncture with a contaminated object or if you have any questions.

Be sure that the supervisor of the employee is notified – same time; same day.

1. If it has been determined that the employee needs to be seen, please advise that they can seek care from a health care provider of their choice or send them to Adventist Health - Parkrose - Medical Plaza located at 1350 NE 122nd Ave. Suite 200.
2. *This step is only if the employee needs to be seen and chooses to seek care with Adventist Health - Parkrose:*

Send completed Form #7 (Unanticipated/Accidental Body Fluid Exposure Report) to Stefanie Edenburn for any incident regardless if the employee sought treatment or not.

- Note: Incidents involving punctures with sharp instruments / devices will also be kept in a log at the MESD when the employee reports to the Nurse Consultant.
- Exposed employee: Complete Form #7 and forward to your supervisor within 24 hours of exposure.
