

**RESOLUTION TO SET MEAL PRICES
FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR**

WHEREAS, In December 2010, the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 USC 1760) was amended as part of the federal budget process to include a requirement that meal prices for students not eligible for the free or reduced meal program are set at an equitable price to what the Federal government is providing under the National School Lunch Program; and

WHEREAS, Section 205 of the amendment required the Oregon Department of Education to ensure that school districts were charging students for paid meals at a price that is on average equal to the difference between free meal reimbursement and paid meal reimbursement; required schools that charged less to gradually increase their prices over time until they met the requirement; and established a maximum annual increase in the paid meal price of 10 cents annually, but allowed schools to establish a higher increase at their discretion; and

WHEREAS, this requirement also provides an option for schools to choose to cover the difference in revenue with non-Federal funds instead of raising paid meal prices; and

WHEREAS, the District is required to annually review the meal prices and set prices in accordance with 42 USC 1760; and

WHEREAS, the resolution for meal prices will expire on June 30, 2022, and the District needs to set prices for the new school year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, David Douglas School District No. 40 will increase the meal prices for elementary, middle and high school lunch for 2022-23 by 10 cents, and increase the adult lunch and the adult breakfast prices for 2022-23 by 10 cents as follows:

\$3.05 elementary lunch
\$3.35 middle and high school lunch
\$4.60 adult lunch / \$2.85 adult breakfast

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that David Douglas School District No. 40 will set a price of \$2.00 for elementary, middle and high school breakfasts for 2022-23. All of the District's elementary and middle schools, as well as David Douglas High School and the Fir Ridge Campus, will not be charged this breakfast price as they qualify for free meals under the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). However, the Community Transition Program (CTP) is not eligible under CEP and will be charged the \$2.00 breakfast price.
