

2024 YOUTHTRUTH SURVEY RESULTS

Students at David Douglas Online Academy (Grades 3-12) were surveyed in December 2023 about their perceptions of their school in terms of Engagement, Academic Challenge, Instructional Methods, Culture, Belonging, and Relationships. In addition, students provided feedback about School Safety and Emotional and Mental Health. Students in grades 9-12 were asked questions about College and Career Readiness.

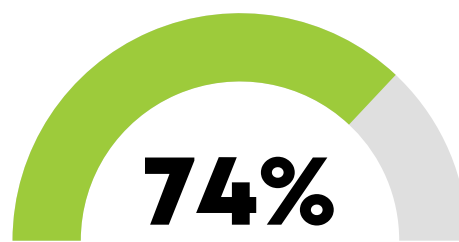
We heard from 28% of students in grades 9-12, 120% of students in grades 3-5, and a 102% response rate from students in grades 6-8. with the help of the nonprofit YouthTruth, analyzed their responses to use for decision-making and improvements.

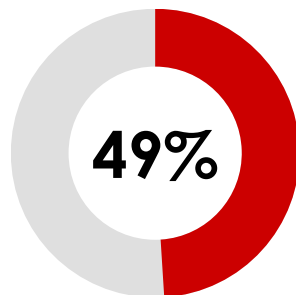
"My teachers let me share my ideas and treat me with lots of respect and kindness. my teachers also help me with something if i need help. I overall love my teachers and they are very caring."
